Job Description

The Role of Overflow's Student Ministry Coordinator:

This position helps to fulfill the purpose of Cibolo Creek Community Church by partnering with parents to ensure 6th-12th grade students are introduced to a personal relationship with Christ, nurtured to Christlike maturity, and mobilized to make a difference in their world for the Kingdom of God. Overflow Student ministry is seeking a male, part-time candidate who is passionate about mentoring and discipling young men and will prioritize building and nurturing those relationships.

Statement of Work:

Male, Part-Time position, Up to 29 hours per week Reports to Ashley Tran, Student Ministry Pastor

The Primary Responsibilities of the Student Ministry Coordinator role:

Provides support to the Student Pastor for the planning, implementation, and administration of all facets of the Cibolo Creek Community Church Student Ministry, while intentionally pursuing discipleship opportunities for male 6th-12th grade students.

The Specific Responsibilities of the Student Ministry Coordinator role:

- Discipleship of 6th-12th grade students, with an intentional focus on male students.
- Assist with the programming, planning, and production of Sunday morning middle school small groups, high school Sunday pre-service hangout, and Wednesday evening student events.
- Assist with teaching on Wednesday nights.
- Assist with the programming, planning, and production of special events designed to accomplish the priorities of a purpose-driven, seeker-sensitive student ministry. This includes, but is not exclusive to outreach events, service opportunities, camps, and mission trips.
- Work alongside Student Ministry volunteers to provide encouragement and support, and help equip them when needed, for their given role.
- Assist the Student Pastor as a liaison between parents and the church to provide resources and support for parents of children in dealing with crucial family issues and incorporating the efforts of Cibolo Creek's Student Ministry into their home. Together with the Student Pastor, own the value of partnering with parents in the spiritual growth of middle school and high school students, equipping and supporting parents, and elevating crucial issues to the Student Pastor.
- Assist the Student Pastor and student volunteer team in creating a safe, welcoming space for students to explore their faith and experience biblical community.
- Occasionally assist with church-wide efforts, as dictated by the Student Pastor and Executive Pastor.

- Attend weekly staff prayer and meetings with Cibolo Creek Church Staff.
- Pursue personal development and spiritual growth opportunities.

Qualifications:

- Male candidate who is a follower of Jesus Christ.
- A high school diploma or equivalent, but some college experience preferred.
- At least two years of experience leading within a student ministry as a staff member or volunteer.
- Actively pursuing a close relationship with Jesus Christ (i.e., actively attending worship within a body of believers, involved in a small group, in the Word daily, etc.).
- Experience teaching the Word in a small and large group setting and facilitating small group discussion.
- A passion to raise up the next generation of disciples for Jesus Christ.
- Exhibit integrity to lead by example.
- Ability to stay accountable to meet deadlines and finish tasks with excellence.
- Willing to serve as a team player with the student ministry team to communicate and collaborate, especially when brainstorming effective ways to reach students for Christ.
- Willingness to work flexible hours, on weekends, and during school breaks to meet with students and their families when they are most available.
- Willingness to demonstrate support and care for students by showing up at their activities outside of church events and regular programming (these are often school or sport events).
- A student of Jesus who is constantly seeking out opportunities to grow and learn in their personal walk with Christ.
- Other duties as assigned.

Bonus Qualification: Experience leading worship to assist coaching and mentoring our student worship band.
